Dear

As you are aware, Government of Maharashtra has approved January 2 as the Raising Day of Maharashtra State Police. It is necessary for all Unit Commanders to actively associate in celebrating this day as the Raising Day by organizing various programmes during 2nd to 6th January, 2018. These programmes should highlight the commitment of the force to improve conviction rate through improved supervision and monitoring of crime investigation and prosecution. During this week we should highlight the commitment of the force to provide a safe and secure environment for the citizens of Maharashtra with special emphasis on dedicating the coming year to provide a secure environment for women, senior citizens, children, minorities and socially underprivileged.

2. All the unit commanders are requested to host programmes aimed at increased Police Community contact. Some of the programmes that could be held this year are:

- a. Some programmes like rally on women safety by college students, plays on women safety, women self defense programmes etc. Help of NGO's and Universities can also be taken.
- b. Organizing visits of School Children to all Police Stations where they could have an interactive session with the Police Stations in-charge, from 2nd January to 5th January. They could also be shown Police weapons and other articles of interest and curiosity to children.
- c. Holding band displays and street plays in public places on various security related issues.

- d. Where feasible, Police officers could address students in colleges on traffic issues, safety and security issues.
- e. Organize special drive to return valuable "Muddemal" to the complainants after completing legal procedure during the week.
- f. Holding a seminar at Unit Head Quarters of interest to the community stakeholders in which various sections of the Society could participate.

3. The above list is indicative and not exhaustive. Unit commanders can organize various other suitable programmes and other such programmes that have elicited good response from the public in the past.

4. The Unit Commanders are requested to give wide publicity to the programmes organized on Raising Day through banners and pamphlets etc. The Unit Commanders should organize the Raising Day programme to the best of their abilities.

5. A list of the events proposed to be held in each Unit may be furnished to this office by 20th December, 2017.
